The Williamstown Botanic Gardens holds rare and significant trees, has a formal palm avenue and a charming Edwardian ornamental pond among its attractions. Opened in 1860, it is one of Victoria's first public gardens. The gardens are listed on the Victorian Heritage Register for their historical, aesthetic, scientific (horticultural) and social significance to the State of Victoria.
