The leisurely walk is about one and a half hours followed by morning tea. Highlights are the internationally accredited Dryland Eucalyptus Arboretum, Sensory Garden, Pollinator Beds, the Mixed Garden Beds with Australian, Southern African, Mediterranean, Californian, Central and South American, Bushfoods and Victorian Volcanic Plains indigenous plants.

Tour will be followed by refreshments at the Depot.
